You are hereby notified on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On May 23, 2018, Sycamore Gas Company ("Sycamore") filed an Unopposed Motion to Dismiss Sycamore Gas Company from Phase Two of Tax Investigation ("Motion"). In its Motion, Sycamore requests that it be dismissed as a Respondent from Phase 2 of the Commission's investigation into the impacts of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 because the issues in Phase 2 will be addressed in its pending rate case, Cause No. 45072. Sycamore notes that the evidentiary hearing in its rate case is scheduled to be held on October 3, 2018, which is earlier than the hearings scheduled for Phase 2. Therefore, the rate case presents a more efficient means for presentation and resolution of the Phase 2 issues. In addition, Sycamore has consulted with the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor and it has no objection to the Motion.

The Presiding Officers, having considered the Motion, GRANT Sycamore's request to be dismissed without prejudice from Phase 2 of the Commission's investigation in Cause No. 45032. The caption of this Cause shall be revised on all future filings as follows:
