PETITIONER'S SECOND NOTICE OF CORRECTIONS TO ZAC ELLIOT'S CASE-IN-CHIEF TESTIMONY

Petitioner Indianapolis Power & Light Company respectfully notifies the Commission and parties to this Cause of the following additional corrections to the case-in-chief testimony of Zac Elliot that was prefilled with the Commission on May 27, 2016.

In responding to the Commission's Docket Entry questions dated September 6, 2016 (specifically, question 2), Petitioner discovered that the table on pages 12-13 of Mr. Elliot's testimony contained an error as to the amount of Shared Savings, which also results in corrections to the Subtotal and Total in the table. In addition, consistent with the question and response to Docket Entry question 3, Petitioner has revised the table on pages 12-13 to exclude persisting lost revenues from previous program years.

The corrected/updated Q&A 31 reads as shown on the next page (the highlighting shows the numbers that have been corrected). Petitioner plans to submit Mr. Elliot's August 26, 2016 Corrected Case in Chief Testimony, along with this additional September 6, 2016 correction, into evidence at the evidentiary hearing in this Cause.
