Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and with the consent of the parties, the Presiding Officers notify the parties and other interested individuals of the following:

1. **WebEx Hearing.** The evidentiary hearing scheduled for Tuesday, October 27, 2020, at 9:30 a.m. shall be conducted at the scheduled date and time via WebEx video conferencing. Prior to the hearing, the parties will receive an email with the WebEx participation information. Members of the public and those not directly participating in the hearing may listen to the hearing via teleconference by calling 1-240-454-0887 and, when prompted, enter the access code 172 760 6757, followed by the pound key.

2. **Exhibits.** Each party shall e-mail the Presiding Administrative Law Judge and the other parties with a list of the exhibits the party intends to offer into evidence at the hearing no later than 24 hours before the scheduled time of the evidentiary hearing, identifying each exhibit and its exhibit number. If a party intends to offer an exhibit that has not yet been prefiled or an exhibit containing corrections or revisions not yet prefiled, the party shall also prefile that exhibit with the Commission no later than 24 hours before the hearing. The parties shall mail hard copies of their respective exhibits to the Commission, addressed to the attention of the Commission’s Court Reporters, within 30 days of the hearing date.
