A CHANGE IN RATES AND
CHARGES BY THE MICHIGAN
CITY DEPARTMENT OF
WATER WORKS**
Michigan City, Indiana

Notice is hereby given that the
Michigan City, Indiana Depart-
ment of Water Works, under and
pursuant to the Public Service
Commission Act, as amended,
filed with the Indiana Utility Regu-
latory Commission on or about
May 4, 2022 a decrease in its
schedule of rates and charges to
reflect the elimination of utility
receipts tax in the calculation of
rates and charges pursuant to
House Enrolled Act ("HEA") 1002
(Public Law 138). The decrease
in these rates and charges is
applicable to all customers
except wholesale customers. The
decrease in rates and charges
results in a \$0.51 reduction in the
average residential monthly bill
assuming 803 cubic feet.

The changes in schedules of
rates submitted to the Commis-
sion are based solely upon HEA
1002, recently passed by Gener-
al Assembly. The decrease to
rates and charges shall apply
following final approval by the
Commission of July 1, 2022,
whichever is later.
