The State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan Program is pleased to announce that the Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) for the City of Martinsville is approved. Our review was conducted in accordance with the provisions of Indiana Code 5-1.2-3. The environmental review, including a 30-day public comment period, was completed as part of the U.S. HUD/Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs Community Development Block Grant process. Environmental correspondence and comments from environmental review authorities were supplied to the SRF Loan Program and found to be adequate.

The proposed City of Martinsville Water System Improvements project includes:

- Redevelopment of existing wellfield with the installation of three (3) new groundwater wells, along with associated site piping, site electrical and SCADA system;
- Decommissioning of existing wells;
- Improvements to the existing water treatment building, including a new sanitary lift station;
- Construction of new office and lab building; and
- Distribution system improvements, including:
 - o Replacement of approximately 11,200 linear feet of 4- to 12-inch water mains, along with associated hydrants, valves, and other appurtenances;
 - o Replacement of the Hacker Creek Booster Station; and
 - o Replacement of approximately 142 service connections, 4,250 linear feet of ³/₄ inch service lines and installation of new water meter assemblies.

The project replaces the existing wells which require frequent maintenance and are experiencing a reduction in capacity. The project improves the existing treatment facilities and adds a new lab building and office for the operating staff. The project addresses the city's distribution system problems by replacing aging water mains and a booster station. Overall, the project provides an adequate volume of finished water to the distribution system and provides operational flexibility for maintenance and reliability.

There are no Green Project Reserve (GPR) components identified in the project at this time. Green components may be identified prior to loan closing. Please note that in order to receive an interest rate break for the above mentioned Green Project Reserve (GPR) components, the community must certify that they are included in the design and are individually identified in the bidding of the project before a loan is closed.

This approval is for administrative purposes only and does not relieve the community of its responsibility to properly design, build and effectively operate and maintain the proposed facilities covered by this approval.

This approval is contingent upon the issuance of all required permits including the construction permit as issued by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management. Plans and specifications should be completed as soon as possible and submitted to IDEM with the front-end documentation. Information pertaining to the bid and contract reviews is enclosed for convenience.

As a reminder, the project must be completed within 24 months of loan closing, with a copy of the Certificate of Substantial Completion on file with the SRF Loan Program to avoid the 1% non-use fee on any undrawn funds.

Please note that the 2014 American Iron and Steel Requirement applies to this project. Therefore, iron and steel products specified for the project must be manufactured in the United States. Please refer to this link http://water.epa.gov/grants_funding/aisrequirement.cfm, where EPA has included guidance and other 2014 American Iron and Steel information. If you have any questions about the 2014 American Iron and Steel Requirement, contact Indiana Finance Authority Compliance Officer Amy Henninger at (317) 232-6566.

The City of Martinsville's next step is to contact its financial advisor and its nationally recognized bond counsel to assist in preparing the appropriate financial and legal documents needed to close Martinsville's SRF loan. All SRF Loan Program requirements, including bidding the entire SRF-financed project, must be completed prior to the City of Martinsville receiving SRF financing.

The SRF Loan Program looks forward to financing the proposed Water System Improvements project for the City of Martinsville.
