SECOND AMENDED COMPLIANCE FILING

Bright House Networks Information Services (Indiana), LLC ("BHNIS") and Time Warner Cable Information Services (Indiana), LLC ("TWCIS", and together with BHNIS, each individually a "Charter Entity" and collectively the "Charter Entities"), by counsel, respectfully submit this Compliance Filing No. 2 to the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in response to the June 2, 2021 Order of the Commission (the "Order")¹ in the above-referenced Cause. This Second Amended Compliance Filing modifies and replaces the Charter Entities' Amended Compliance Filing submitted to the Commission on August 17, 2021 in this Cause. In furtherance thereof, the Charter Entities state the following.

1. Notice of Change – Final Order: Condition I

The Order designates each Charter Entity as an eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") in its respective Rural Digital Opportunity Fund ("RDOF")-awarded census blocks in Indiana (the "RDOF Census Blocks"). Since the issuance of the Order, the Charter Entities have

decided to provide telecommunications services directly to all voice customers (both Lifeline and non-Lifeline) located in the RDOF Census Blocks as authorized under their existing Certificates of Territorial Authority ("CTA"), instead of relying on Spectrum Advanced Services, LLC to provide interconnected VoIP services to certain of such customers.² Accordingly, each Charter Entity is submitting a Notice of Change to update its Certificate of Territorial Authority to inform the Commission that, as an ETC, each Charter Entity will provide (i) telecommunications services directly to all voice customers (both Lifeline and non-Lifeline) located in the RDOF Census Blocks in accordance with its existing CTA, and (ii) broadband Internet access services, through an affiliate, to all broadband service customers located in the RDOF Census Blocks.

2. <u>Certification – Final Order: Condition J</u>

As discussed above, the Charter Entities have decided to provide telecommunications services directly to all voice customers (both Lifeline and non-Lifeline) located in the RDOF Census Blocks as authorized under their existing CTAs. Accordingly, each Charter Entity certifies that it will comply with all applicable requirements related to the provision of RDOF-supported voice services (both Lifeline and non-Lifeline) throughout the RDOF Census Blocks. These requirements include payment of all applicable fees and regulatory charges, such as contributions to the Indiana Universal Service Fund and/or payment of the Indiana public utility fee, related to the provision of voice services (both Lifeline and non-Lifeline) in the RDOF Census Blocks.

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² As indicated in the Charter Entities' ETC designation Order, the FCC has not classified interconnected VoIP as a telecommunications service or an information service. Nothing in this filing is intended or shall be deemed to constitute agreement by the Charter Entities regarding the classification of any voice services other than the specific voice services offered in Indiana in connection with the FCC's RDOF program and discussed in this submission, or to limit or prejudice any rights the Charter Entities may have or positions they may take before the FCC, any other state or regulatory or legislative bodies, courts of applicable jurisdiction, or in any other forum relating to the classification and/or treatment of interconnected VoIP service.
