**PSI ENERGY, INC. MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

PSI Energy, Inc. ("PSI") hereby respectfully requests the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") for an extension of time to file its Real Time Pricing ("RTP") Report, and in support hereof, states as follows:

1. On November 19, 2004, the Commission issued an Order finding that PSI should file its RTP Collaborative Report with the Commission on or before January 31, 2005.

2. Despite due diligence by PSI and the Collaborative parties, more time is needed for PSI to formulate its RTP Collaborative Report and to allow for further negotiations.

Therefore, PSI requests an extension of four (4) weeks in which to file its report and that such filing should be due on or before February 28, 2005.

3. All Collaborative Parties have been informed of PSI's request and PSI has received no objections to date.

**WHEREFORE**, PSI respectfully requests the Commission to grant its Motion for an extension of time in which to file PSI's RTP Collaborative Report to and including February 28, 2005.

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
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
