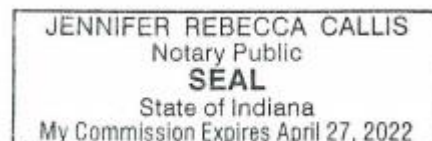

You are hereby notified that the Indianapolis Sailing Club, Inc. located at 11325 Fall Creek Road, Fishers, IN has applied to the Division of Law Enforcement of the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, under IC 14-15-7-3 and 312 IAC 5-3-1, for a permit to conduct recreational events on Geist Reservoir in Marion & Hamilton counties. The recreational events requested in the application are sailboat races, such as those that have been conducted annually on the reservoir since 1955. Sailboat races will be conducted in the year 2022 as follows:

Every Wednesday evening, from May 4, thru September 28, starting at 6:30 PM; every Sunday afternoon, from April 9 thru October 30, starting at 12:30 PM; the following Sunday mornings, beginning at 10:00 AM: April 10, 24, May 1, 8, 15, 22, June 5, 12, 19, 26, July 10, 17, 24, 31, August 7, 14, 21, 28, September 11, 18, 25, and October 2, 9, 16, 23, 30; the following Saturday mornings beginning at 10:00 AM: April 9, 23, 30, May 7, 14, 21, 28, June 4, 11, 18, 25, July 2, 9, 16, 23, 30, August 6, 13, 20, 27, September 3, 10, 17, 24, and October 1, 8, 15, 22, 29; the following Saturday afternoons at 1:00 PM: April 9, 23, 30, May 7, 14, 21, June 4, 11, 18, 25, July 9, 16, 23, 30, August 6, 13, 20, 27, September 10, 17, 24, and October 1, 8, 15, 22, 29. The time duration of these races can range from one to five hours. The availability of the wind will dictate how much time is actually utilized on the water. These are the anticipated times.

The length and layout of racecourses will be dictated by wind and weather conditions, and will be set up in such a manner as to allow clear passage of other watercraft to all areas of the reservoir.

Ice sailing can happen when safe ice is present (usually late December thru mid-February). Courses can be of any length and will be located anywhere where the ice is safe.

Any person objecting to such an event may do either or both of the following:

- (A) File a petition with the central office of the division requesting an informal hearing that is signed by at least twenty-five (25) individuals who are at least 18 years old and who reside in Marion or Hamilton County. A hearing under this clause is governed by 312 IAC 2-3.
- (B) Request the division notify the petitioner in writing when an initial determination is made to issue or deny the license. Following the receipt of notice under this clause, a petitioner may request administrative review of the determination under 312 IAC 3-1.
