- 2. In the original version of Petitioner's Exh. JRB-2, the Total Extensions and Replacements amount of \$29,249,878 (Column A, Line 15) comes from Mr. Jacob's testimony (see Petitioner's Exh. JRB, p. 43, l. 14). Please explain why the Total Extensions and

Replacements amount was changed to \$31,175,763 in the revised version of Petitioner's Exh. JRB-2 that was submitted in the Docket Entry Response.
