LMH Utilities Corp. filed a Petition on October 16, 2019 with the Indiana Regulatory Commission under Cause No. 45307-U. This Petition requests an increase in the rates charged by LMH for sewer service to all customers. This increase in rates is the first for LMH since 2009. Based on a review of its operating costs, and advice from its Certified Public Accountants, LMH has sought an increase of approximately 95%. The average bill for residential customers after the increase will be approximately \$85.00 per month. In addition, this Petition requests an increase in the wholesale service rate to \$14.98 per thousand gallons of sewage processed. We have also proposed to increase the charge for returned checks to \$30.00.

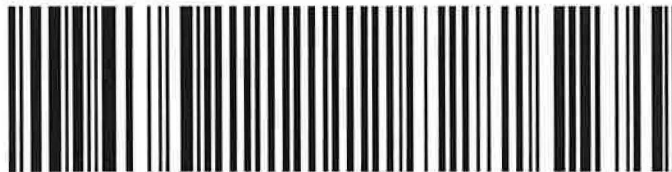
