You are hereby notified on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission has caused the following entry to be made:

On June 30, 2020, American Suburban Utilities (“ASU”) filed its *Unopposed Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule* in the above-captioned Cause (“Motion”). ASU requests that the procedural schedule be modified to promote the administrative efficiency of this Cause. The Presiding Officers, having reviewed the Motion hereby GRANT the Motion. Therefore, the procedural schedule is modified as follows:

1. On or before September 30, 2020, ASU shall file notification that all construction activities have been completed and provide to the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor (“OUCC”) the final inspection reports from TBird Engineering, final completion certificate and notification that final payment has been made, Certified Record Documents as submitted to IDEM’s Facility Construction and Engineering Support Section, and the application for renewal of the NPDES Permit as submitted to the IDEM NPDES Permit Section.
2. The OUCC and any intervenors shall file the testimony and evidence constituting the respective objections, if any, to the Phase III rates on or before November 18, 2020.
3. ASU shall file its responsive testimony on or before December 18, 2020.
4. The Evidentiary Hearing presently scheduled for October 5, 2020 is continued to January 25, 2021 at 9:30 a.m., in Room 222 of the PNC Center, 101 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana.
5. Discovery up until the date that ASU files its notice of completion shall be responded to within 10 business days of receipt. Upon the filing of ASU’s notice of completion, discovery shall be responded to within 5 business days.
