

To be inserted after the first full paragraph on Page 2, and before the paragraph beginning “Based upon the applicable law and evidence...”

Pursuant to informal discussion held among the parties prior to and following the evidentiary hearing on January 17, 2020, the parties stipulated to a schedule whereby the hearing would be continued and Indiana American would submit an application for certificate of territorial authority and evidence in support thereof, or alternatively, a statement why a certificate of territorial authority is not required. On January 27, 2020, Indiana American submitted its Verified Application for Certificate of Territorial Authority and supporting exhibits. No party opposed the application. Commencing at 9:00 a.m. on February 11, 2020 in Room 224, PNC Center, 101 W. Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, the Commission resumed the evidentiary hearing to receive the Verified Application for Certificate of Territorial Authority and supporting exhibits, which were admitted into the record in this Cause without objection.

To be inserted as a new Paragraph 7.F:

F. Certificate of Territorial Authority.

Indiana American’s Verified Application for Certificate of Territorial Authority presents the unincorporated area within which it will provide service, consisting of approximately 1.5 square miles in Vigo County in the vicinity of the Town of Riley. Indiana American provided a legal description and map for this area, as well as evidence that it has notified other sewer service providers in the area of the request for a CTA allowing it to continue to serve this small area. Specifically, the description of the area that will be covered by the requested CTA consists of unincorporated areas in Vigo County as follows:

W 1/2, S15, T11N, R8W
S16, T11N, R8W
N 1/2, S21, T11N, R8W
NW 1/4, S22, T11N, R8W

No Party has objected to the requested CTA. We find that Indiana American has shown itself to have the lawful power and authority to apply for the CTA and to provide the proposed service in the area, as well as the financial ability to provide said proposed service to the area. Further, we find that public convenience and necessity requires Indiana American’s continued service in this area. We therefore find that a certificate of territorial authority to provide sewer service in the area identified should be granted.

To be inserted as a new Ordering Paragraph:

Indiana American is hereby granted a certificate of territorial authority to provide sewage disposal service within the portion of Vigo County, Indiana described by the legal description set forth above. This Order shall be the sole evidence of the grant of such certificate of territorial authority.
