JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Duke Energy Indiana, LLC (“Duke Energy Indiana”) submits this Joint Motion for Extension of Procedural Schedule to the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) on behalf of itself, the Duke Industrial Group (“IG”) and the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor (“OUCC”) (collectively, the “Parties”). In support thereof, Duke Energy Indiana states as follows:

1. Pursuant to the procedural schedule in this proceeding, the hearing is scheduled for January 20, 2023.
2. Duke Energy Indiana, OUCC and IG have been engaged in settlement discussions and require an additional period of time to finalize those discussions and complete a written settlement agreement and prepare supporting testimony. The Parties are therefore requesting the

Commission approve the following amended procedural schedule:

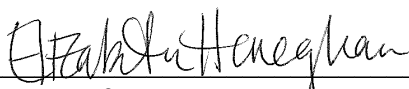
February 3, 2023:	The date by which the settlement agreement and settlement supporting testimony is to be filed with the Commission.
February 13, 2023:	The date by which opposing testimony and attachments are to be filed with the Commission.
The week of February 27, 2023:	The date by which the hearing concerning this Petition is to be held.

3. Duke Energy Indiana is authorized to file this Joint Motion on behalf of the Parties.

WHEREFORE, Duke Energy Indiana, the OUCC and IG respectfully request the Presiding Officers grant this Joint Motion and order the deadlines for pre-filing the settlement agreement and settlement supporting testimony of February 3, 2023, any opposing testimony of February 13, 2023 and the hearing be scheduled for the week of February 27, 2023.
