On August 17, 2021, Duke Energy Indiana, LLC ("Duke Energy Indiana" or "Petitioner") filed a *Motion for Virtual Evidentiary Hearing* ("Motion") requesting the evidentiary hearing scheduled in this Cause on September 9, 2021, be converted to a remote WebEx hearing. Duke Energy Indiana advised that Petitioner and the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor ("OUCC") have agreed to waive cross examination of the witnesses and that the OUCC has no objection to the evidentiary hearing being conducted via WebEx video conference.

The Presiding Officers, having considered the Motion, GRANT the Motion. The evidentiary hearing scheduled to commence at 1:30 p.m. on September 9, 2021, shall be conducted at the scheduled date and time via WebEx. If a party intends to offer an exhibit that has not yet been prefiled or an exhibit containing corrections or revisions not yet prefiled, the party shall also prefile that exhibit with the Commission on or before September 7, 2021. Hard copies of all hearing exhibits shall be delivered to the Commission, addressed to the attention of the Commission's court reporters, on or before September 13, 2021.
