True-Up Report

Following are responses to questions posed to the City of Columbus, Indiana Municipal Water Utility (the "Utility") by the Office of Utility Consumer Counselor ("OUCC") in their response to the Utility's True-Up Report dated September 26, 2022 for Cause No. 45427.

The Utility was asked to provide the expected date of repayment of the Waterworks Revenue Bond Anticipation Notes, Series 2021 (the "BANs"). The BANs had a maturity date of June 3, 2022, which is also the date funds were received by The Bank of New York Mellon to repay the BANs.

The Utility was also asked when the \$1,715,000 loan from the sewage works was anticipated to be repaid back to the Utility. The Utility received the funds from the sewage works on June 1, 2022, prior to paying off the BANs. Those funds, in addition to cash on hand, were used to repay the BANs.
