You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission has caused the following entry to be made:

On September 24, 2018, Duke Energy Indiana, LLC ("Duke") filed its Petition for approval of an Alternative Regulatory Plan ("ARP") in the above-captioned Cause. On September 25, 2018, Duke filed the Direct Testimony of Andrew S. Ritch, and on January 22, 2019, Duke filed the Rebuttal Testimony of Andrew S. Ritch. The Presiding Officers direct Duke to respond to the following requests on or before January 28, 2019.

- 1. Please explain the pricing construct that will ensue for customers participating in this ARP when net metering ends in 2032.
2. Duke's Petition and Mr. Ritch's Direct Testimony state that participation in its solar leasing program would be limited to a total of 12 MW in the aggregate. However, in Mr. Ritch's Rebuttal Testimony, he states that the cap for participation would be 10 MW. Please confirm that Duke proposes capping the solar leasing program at 12 MW in the aggregate.
