1 Q1. Please state your name, business address and title.

2 A1. My name is Andrew S. Campbell. I am the Director of Regulatory Support
3 & Planning for Northern Indiana Public Service Company LLC
4 ("NIPSCO"). My business address is 1500 165th Street, Hammond,
5 Indiana 46320.

6 Q2. On whose behalf are you submitting this direct testimony?

7 A2. I am submitting this testimony on behalf of Joint Petitioners NIPSCO and
8 Indiana Crossroads Wind Generation LLC ("Joint Venture").

9 Q3. Please describe your educational and employment background.

10 A3. I graduated from Purdue University Calumet with a Bachelor of Science in
11 Mechanical Engineering and graduate studies in Interdisciplinary
12 Engineering. Additionally, I graduated with a Master of Business
13 Administration from the University of Notre Dame. I began my
14 employment with NIPSCO in June of 2009 as an Operations Analysis
15 Engineer. In September of 2011, I was promoted to the Manager of
16 Operations & Market Support and in May of 2013, assumed the role of

1 Manager of Planning & Regulatory Support. In September of 2017, I was
2 promoted to my current role as Director of Regulatory Support &
3 Planning. Prior to joining NIPSCO, I worked as an engineer for an
4 industrial manufacturing company that specialized in engine attachments
5 for marine and small power generation applications. I am also a veteran
6 of the Army National Guard.

7 **Q4. What are your responsibilities as Director of Regulatory Support &**
8 **Planning?**

9 A4. As the Director of Regulatory Support & Planning, I am responsible for
10 leading the regulatory support and financial planning functions for the
11 Energy Supply & Optimization ("ES&O") department within NIPSCO,
12 whereby my team supports NIPSCO's operations within the electric and
13 natural gas markets. More specifically, my team is responsible for leading
14 all electric and natural gas rate case related support activities for the ES&O
15 department, supporting the forecast and reconciliation of NIPSCO's Fuel
16 Adjustment Clause ("FAC"), Regional Transmission Organization
17 ("RTO") Adjustment, Resource Adequacy ("RA") Adjustment, Green
18 Power Rider, Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA"), leading the development of
19 NIPSCO's natural gas and electric hedging programs, and supporting

1 NIPSCO's financial and business planning cadence. Most recently, I have
2 been leading the commercial execution of NIPSCO's generation strategy
3 outlined within its 2018 Integrated Resource Plan ("2018 IRP").

4 **Q5. Have you previously testified before this or any other regulatory**
5 **commission?**

6 A5. Yes. Most relative, I filed testimony before the Indiana Utility Regulatory
7 Commission ("Commission") in Joint Petitioners' (NIPSCO and Indiana
8 Crossroads Wind Generation LLC) request for a certificate of public
9 convenience and necessity ("CPCN") to purchase and acquire (indirectly
10 through a joint venture structure) a 302 megawatt ("MW") wind farm
11 ("Crossroads Project") in Cause No. 45310. I have also filed testimony
12 before the Commission in NIPSCO's request for approval and associated
13 cost recovery of (1) a Solar Energy Purchase Agreement with Brickyard
14 Solar, LLC and (2) a Solar Generation and Energy Storage Energy Purchase
15 Agreement with Greensboro Solar Center, LLC currently pending in Cause
16 No. 45403; NIPSCO's request for a CPCN to purchase and acquire
17 (indirectly through a joint venture structure) a 102 MW wind farm
18 (Rosewater Project) in Cause No. 45194; NIPSCO's request for approval
19 and associated cost recovery of a wind purchased power agreement with

1 (1) Jordan Creek Wind Farm LLC in Cause No. 45195, and (2) Roaming
2 Bison Wind Farm LLC in Cause No. 45196. I have also submitted
3 testimony in NIPSCO's electric rate case in Cause No. 45159; NIPSCO's gas
4 rate case in Cause No. 44988; NIPSCO's request for approval of its 2018
5 Hedging Plan, 2019 Hedging Plan, and 2020 Hedging Plan (Cause Nos.
6 38706-FAC-118, 38706-FAC-122, and 38706-FAC-126); NIPSCO's request
7 for approval of an amendment to NIPSCO's 2017-2018 financing authority
8 (Cause No. 45020); and in some of the following tracker filings: GCA
9 tracker filings (Cause No. 43629-GCA-XX), FAC tracker filings (Cause No.
10 38706-FAC-XX), RA Adjustment tracker filings (Cause No. 44155-RA-XX),
11 and RTO Adjustment tracker filings (Cause No. 44156-RTO-XX). I also
12 filed testimony before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in
13 Docket EL19-2775-000 (NIPSCO request for authorization to undertake
14 affiliate sales for the Rosewater Project).

15 **Q6. What is the purpose of your direct testimony?**

16 A6. The purpose of my direct testimony is to support Joint Petitioners' request
17 for modification of the Commission's February 19, 2020 Order issued in
18 Cause No. 45310 (the "45310 Order") requesting authorization to use a
19 Contract for Differences ("CFD") as an additional alternative to the Build

1 Transfer Agreement Power Purchase Agreement ("BTA PPA")¹ and the
 2 Back-Stop PPA as contemplated and approved in the 45310 Order. The
 3 CFD, BTA PPA, and Back-Stop PPA are collectively referred to herein as
 4 the "Offtake Agreements"). Joint Petitioners urge the Commission, after
 5 considering the evidence in support of its petition herein, to find the
 6 modification to be reasonable and in the public interest and promptly enter
 7 an order approving NIPSCO request in this proceeding for the
 8 modification in its entirety.

9 **Q7. Are you sponsoring any attachments to your testimony?**

10 A7. Yes. I am sponsoring the following attachments, all of which were
 11 prepared by me or under my direction and supervision.

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1 Q8. Please describe the relief granted in the 45310 Order.

2 A8. In its 45310 Order, the Commission found:

3 1. The Crossroads Project, the Build Transfer Agreement, the
4 BTA PPA, and the Back-Stop PPA are a clean energy project under Ind.
5 Code§ 8-1-8.8.3, and are reasonable and necessary under Ind. Code § 8-1-
6 8.8-11.

7 2. The Build Transfer Agreement, the BTA PPA, and the Back-
8 Stop PPA are approved.

9 3. The financial incentives, as modified in rebuttal, all as
10 outlined in Paragraph 9.A. of this Order, are approved.

11 4. NIPSCO's costs incurred pursuant to the BTA PPA and/or
12 the Back-Stop PPA shall be recovered through a rate adjustment
13 mechanism pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1-2-42(a) to be administered through
14 NIPSCO's FAC proceeding (or successor mechanism). This recovery shall
15 not be subject to any Ind. Code§ 8-1-2-42(d) tests or FAC benchmarks.

16 5. A certificate of public convenience and necessity for
17 NIPSCO's acquisition of the Crossroads Project though the Joint Venture
18 is approved.

19 6. NIPSCO's ARP outlined in Paragraph 9.C. of this Order is
20 approved.

21 7. NIPSCO shall record its investments in the Joint Venture as
22 a regulatory asset in Account 182.3, and NIPSCO's investment therein shall
23 be amortized over the life of the Crossroads Project. Subject to the caps
24 agreed to on rebuttal, the balance of the regulatory asset shall be included
25 in NIPSCO's net original cost rate base for ratemaking purposes.

26 8. NIPSCO is authorized to defer amortization with respect to
27 each investment in the Joint Venture until such time as the recovery of the
28 amortization of that portion is reflected in rates. NIPSCO is also authorized

1 to accrue post-in-service carrying charges with respect to each investment
2 at NIPSCO's then-approved weighted average cost of capital until a return
3 on that portion is reflected in NIPSCO's rates. Both the deferral of
4 amortization and accrual of PISCC shall be recorded in Account 182.3, and
5 the unamortized balance thereof shall be included in NIPSCO's net
6 original cost rate base for ratemaking purposes.

7 9. To the extent GAAP would treat any aspect of the Joint
8 Venture as debt on NIPSCO's financial statement, such debt is approved,
9 and this Order shall constitute the Commission's certificate therefore.

10 10. NIPSCO shall file a copy of the LLC Agreement and Term
11 Sheet with the Commission under this Cause upon its finalization.

12 11. The Commission declines any jurisdiction over the Joint
13 Venture.

14 12. NIPSCO's request for confidential trade secret treatment is
15 hereby granted, and such Confidential Information shall be excepted from
16 public disclosure.

17 13. This Order shall be effective on and after the date of its
18 approval.

19
20 **Q9. Are Joint Petitioners proposing to modify any of the substantive**
21 **findings in the 45310 Order?**

22 A9. No. All of the substantive findings, including the eight conditions that
23 were agreed to with the OUCC at hearing and approved by the
24 Commission in the 45310 Order, will remain the same. Joint Petitioners
25 are only requesting approval of an additional agreement (the CFD) to
26 effectuate the contemplated transaction already approved by the
27 Commission to the extent the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") does not

1 issue certain guidance (the Related Party Guidance) prior to the date the
2 Crossroads Project goes into commercial operation, which is anticipated to
3 be in the fourth quarter of 2021.

4 **Q10. What portions of the 45310 Order are Joint Petitioners requesting that**
5 **the Commission modify?**

6 A10. Joint Petitioners are requesting that the Commission issue an Order in this
7 proceeding to modify the 45310 Order as follows: Ordering Paragraphs 1
8 and 2 be amended to include the CFD (attached hereto as Confidential
9 Attachment 1-B) as also being a component of the previously approved
10 clean energy project under Ind. Code § 8-1-8.8.3, and reasonable and
11 necessary under Ind. Code § 8-1-8.8-11; Ordering Paragraph 4 be amended
12 to authorize NIPSCO to recover its payments made to Crossroads
13 ProjectCo pursuant to the CFD in addition to the previously approved BTA
14 PPA and the Backstop PPA, through the FAC without regard to Ind. Code
15 § 8-1-2-42(d)(1) through (4) and without regard to any benchmarks
16 established by the Commission for PPAs; and Ordering Paragraph 6 be
17 amended to modify its approved alternative regulatory plan ("ARP") to
18 include the CFD as a possible component of the Joint Venture structure.
19 NIPSCO continues to elect to be subject to Ind. Code § 8-1-2.5-6 for

1 purposes of its modified ARP.

2 **Q11. What is a CFD?**

3 A11. A CFD is a financial instrument that is often used in energy markets to
4 establish a fixed price for energy when a party is not physically transacting
5 in the underlying commodity (in this case, the energy from the Crossroads
6 Project). Under the CFD, NIPSCO would pay to (or receive from)
7 Crossroads ProjectCo (the owner of the Crossroads Project) the difference
8 between the specified contract price and the actual market price
9 (Locational Marginal Pricing ("LMP"), at the Crossroads ProjectCo's
10 Commercial Pricing Node) for the expected energy production from the
11 Crossroads Project. That is, NIPSCO would pay Crossroads ProjectCo the
12 specified contract price, Crossroads ProjectCo would pay NIPSCO the
13 market price, and there would be monthly settlements between the two
14 parties, based on the differences between the two prices and the amount
15 of power covered by the CFD. Ultimately, utilizing the CFD instead of the
16 BTA PPA will have no impact on NIPSCO's customers, as the price that
17 will be paid by customers through the FAC will be the same under either
18 the CFD or the BTA PPA.

1 **Q12. Why would a CFD be necessary for the Crossroads Project?**

2 A12. As more fully discussed by Witness Brummitt, at this time, if NIPSCO were
3 to utilize the BTA PPA, and not receive the Related Party Guidance from
4 the IRS, there is a potential that the Joint Venture may not be able to fully
5 utilize certain tax-related benefits of the Crossroads Project. Were this to
6 occur, it would increase the costs associated with the transactions, which
7 would ultimately be borne by NIPSCO's customers. By utilizing the CFD
8 (which is a "financial" rather than "physical" contract), NIPSCO is able to
9 avoid the potential negative tax implications that would exist if the BTA
10 PPA were used, thereby fully utilizing the tax benefits of the Crossroads
11 Projects for the benefit of NIPSCO's customers. This type of off-take
12 agreement is commonly utilized in joint venture structures. The CFD
13 effectively replaces the BTA PPA to avoid such an outcome until such time
14 as the IRS provides the Related Party Guidance.

15 **Q13. Please demonstrate how a CFD would work using example numbers.**

16 A13. Confidential Attachment 1-C illustrates how the mechanism would work
17 under the BTA PPA and the CFD. It shows the flow of dollars under each
18 arrangement using the same \$/MWh rate and results in the same ultimate
19 charge (for the difference between the contract price and the ultimate LMP

1 revenue received) being credited to or recovered from NIPSCO's
2 customers through the FAC.

3 **Q14. Is NIPSCO requesting a modification to the accounting treatment for the**
4 **recovery of costs associated with the Crossroads Project?**

5 A14. No, NIPSCO is simply using the accounting treatment for the recovery of
6 costs associated with the Crossroads Project for the Offtake Agreements
7 (inclusive of the CFD).

8 **Q15. What is the pricing for the CFD for the Crossroads Project?**

9 A15. The pricing under the CFD for the Crossroads Project is \$ [REDACTED] per MWh.
10 If the CFD is ultimately utilized, the pricing per MWh for the Crossroads
11 Project will be the same as under the BTA PPA.

12 **Q16. How will NIPSCO account for the energy provided by the CFD if it is**
13 **used for the Crossroads Project?**

14 A16. NIPSCO will not take delivery of the energy from Crossroads ProjectCo
15 under a CFD. Instead, NIPSCO will settle each month for the difference
16 between the CFD price and the actual LMP. MISO treats wind energy
17 projects as dispatchable intermittent resources. As such, Crossroads
18 ProjectCo will be subject to real-time Revenue Sufficiency Guarantee and
19 Uninstructed Deviation charges assessed under the Open Access

1 Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff ("MISO
2 Tariff").

3 **Q17. If NIPSCO needs to utilize the CFD, would there be any material impact**
4 **to NIPSCO's customers from NIPSCO utilizing the CFD instead of the**
5 **BTA PPA?**

6 A17. No. There will be no material impact on NIPSCO's customers if the CFD
7 is utilized instead of the BTA PPA. As explained above, the pricing under
8 both the CFD and BTA PPA will be the same. The CFD provides NIPSCO
9 with 100% of the benefit associated with the electrical energy output of the
10 Crossroads Project. As noted above, NIPSCO will not take delivery of the
11 energy from Crossroads ProjectCo under a CFD. Instead, NIPSCO will
12 settle each month for the difference between the CFD price and the actual
13 LMP at the ProjectCo's Commercial Pricing Node. MISO treats wind
14 energy projects as dispatchable intermittent resources. Other benefits (e.g.,
15 UCAP and environmental attributes (the RECs)) and costs (MISO
16 Settlement Charges) addressed in the BTA PPA will be allocated to
17 NIPSCO pursuant to the LLC Agreement.² The LLC Agreement will also
18 address operating procedures/parameters for the Crossroads Project. The

² Joint Venture Operating Agreement ("LLC Agreement").

1 fixed price settlement of the CFD for energy and the allocation of other
2 benefits/costs described herein will ensure that the same economic
3 position relative to the BTA PPA is maintained.

4 **Q18. If the IRS provides the tax guidance that NIPSCO has requested, will**
5 **NIPSCO utilize the CFD or the BTA PPA?**

6 A18. If the IRS guidance is provided, NIPSCO anticipates using the BTA PPA.
7 This remains NIPSCO's preference. However, it is possible that the
8 guidance could be delayed to a point where commercial negotiations with
9 the tax equity partner have advanced to a stage where the CFD approach
10 needs to be used. This is why NIPSCO is requesting the necessary
11 approval to purchase the electrical energy output from Crossroads
12 ProjectCo via a CFD in addition to the BTA PPA or Back-Stop PPA already
13 approved by the Commission. To the extent NIPSCO gains additional
14 clarity around this issue (i.e., if the IRS were to issue the Related Party
15 Guidance), NIPSCO will update the Commission and all parties.

16 **Q19. Why not use the Backstop PPA that was approved in the 45310 Order?**

17 A19. While the Back-Stop PPA was approved by the Commission as the
18 alternative to the BTA PPA, the record demonstrates that the BTA PPA
19 provides more economic benefits to customers than the Backstop PPA.

1 The CFD delivers the same economic benefits to NIPSCO's customers as
2 the BTA PPA.

3 **Q20. Why did Joint Petitioners not propose the CFD in its original filing?**

4 A20. The CFD was proposed during the negotiations with the tax equity partner
5 after issuance of the 45310 Order. NIPSCO and the industry also expected
6 the IRS would have issued the Related Party Guidance by this point in
7 time.

8 **Q21. Why is approval of the modification consistent with the public interest?**

9 A21. As discussed above, adding the CFD as a third option to the BTA PPA and
10 Back-Stop PPA already approved by the Commission for the purchase of
11 the electrical energy output of the Crossroads Project will provide
12 NIPSCO's customers with the same benefits as the BTA PPA.

13 **Q22. Are there any project updates that you would like to share with the**
14 **Commission?**

15 A22. Yes. Construction of the project is progressing: substation civil work
16 began in November 2020; public road improvements are on schedule to be
17 completed by the end of 2020; access road work is on schedule to be
18 completed in spring 2021; foundation work has begun and is planned to
19 be completed by summer 2021; and turbine erection is expected to begin

1 in June 2021. On November 20, 2020, Joint Petitioners executed a First
2 Amendment to Build Transfer Agreement (Confidential Attachment 1-D),
3 which adds that Force Majeure may extend the commercial operations date
4 of the Crossroads Project into 2022, if necessary, and extend the deadline
5 for signing on the tax equity partner to April 15, 2021. The amendment
6 does not alter any economics for customers and in a general sense allows
7 for increased flexibility in light of the extension of the production tax credit
8 qualification. The amendment also optimizes certain environmental
9 permits that will be shared between the Rosewater Wind Farm and this
10 Indiana Crossroads Wind Farm.

11 **Q23. In accordance with Ind. Code § 8-1-2.5-6(d), did NIPSCO publish a notice**
12 **of the filing of the petition in this case in a newspaper of general**
13 **circulation in each county in which NIPSCO provides retail electric**
14 **service?**


15 A23. Yes. Attachment 1-E will be a copy of each of the Publishers' Affidavits
16 associated with the notices published in accordance with the law and
17 Commission practice. This attachment will be organized alphabetically by
18 County, and will be filed with the Commission once all of the Publishers'
19 Affidavits have been received.

1 Q24. Does this conclude your prepared testimony?

2 A24. Yes.

VERIFIED JOINT PETITION

Joint Petitioners Northern Indiana Public Service Company LLC (“NIPSCO”) and Indiana Crossroads Wind Generation LLC (the “Joint Venture”) respectfully petition the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1-2-72, for the modification of the Commission’s February 19, 2020 Order in Cause No. 45310 (the “45310 Order”) authorizing a contract for differences as a third option in addition to the BTA PPA and the Back-Stop PPA as approved in the 45310 Order for the purchase of the electrical energy output of the Crossroads Project.¹ Specifically, Joint Petitioners’

¹ The Crossroads Project will be a wind generation facility with a nameplate capacity of approximately 302 MWs located in White County, Indiana. The Crossroads Project is being constructed by Indiana Crossroads Wind Farm LLC (“Crossroads ProjectCo”). The Build Transfer Agreement is by and

request an amendment to (1) Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 to include the contract for differences as also being a clean energy project under Ind. Code § 8-1-8.8.3, and reasonable and necessary under Ind. Code § 8-1-8.8-11; (2) Ordering Paragraph 4 to authorize NIPSCO to recover its payments made to Crossroads ProjectCo pursuant to the Contract for Differences in addition to the previously approved BTA PPA, and Back-Stop PPA (the “Offtake Agreements”), through the Fuel Adjustment Clause without regard to Ind. Code § 8-1-2-42(d)(1) through (4) and without regard to any benchmarks established by the Commission for PPAs; and (3) Ordering Paragraph 6 to modify its approved alternative regulatory plan to include the contract for differences as a possible component of the Joint Venture structure. NIPSCO continues to elect to be subject to Ind. Code § 8-1-2.5-6 for purposes of its request for the modification of its alternative regulatory plan. In accordance with 170 IAC 1-1.1-8 and 1-1.1-9 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, Joint Petitioners submit the following information in support of this petition.

1. **NIPSCO’s Corporate Status.** NIPSCO is a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the State of Indiana with its principal office and place of business at 801 East 86th Avenue, Merrillville, Indiana. NIPSCO is a wholly-

owned subsidiary of NiSource Inc., an energy holding company whose stock is listed on the New York Stock Exchange.

2. **NIPSCO's Regulated Status.** NIPSCO is a "public utility" within the meaning of Ind. Code § 8-1-2-1 and is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission in the manner and to the extent provided by the Public Service Commission Act, as amended, and other pertinent laws of the State of Indiana. NIPSCO is also an "eligible business" as that term is defined in Ind. Code § 8-1-8.8-6. NIPSCO is also an "energy utility" within the meaning of Ind. Code § 8-1-2.5-2 and provides "retail energy service" as that term is defined by Ind. Code § 8-1-2.5-3. NIPSCO is also subject to the jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC").

3. **NIPSCO's Operations.** NIPSCO is authorized by the Commission to provide electric utility service to the public in all or part of Benton, Carroll, DeKalb, Elkhart, Fulton, Jasper, Kosciusko, LaGrange, Lake, LaPorte, Marshall, Newton, Noble, Porter, Pulaski, Saint Joseph, Starke, Steuben, Warren and White Counties in northern Indiana. NIPSCO owns, operates, manages and controls electric generating, transmission and distribution plant and equipment and related facilities ("Utility Property"), which are used and useful in the production, transmission, distribution and furnishing of electric energy, heat, light and power to the public. The NIPSCO generating facilities have an installed capacity of 2,825 megawatts ("MW") and consist of six (6) separate

generation sites, including two (2) hydroelectric generating plants. NIPSCO's transmission system, with voltages from 69,000 to 765,000 volts, consists of approximately 2,802 circuit miles. NIPSCO is interconnected with six (6) neighboring electric utilities. Pursuant to the Commission's Order dated September 24, 2003 in Cause No. 42349, NIPSCO has transferred functional control of its transmission facilities to the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. ("MISO"), a regional transmission organization operated under the authority of FERC, which administers the use of NIPSCO's transmission system and the economic dispatching of NIPSCO's generating units pursuant to MISO's FERC approved tariff provisions. NIPSCO also engages in power purchase transactions through MISO as necessary to meet the demands of its customers.

4. **Request for Relief.** All of the findings, including the eight conditions that were agreed to with the OUCC at hearing and approved by the Commission, will remain the same. Joint Petitioners are only requesting approval of an additional mechanism to effectuate the Joint Venture and the purchase of its energy output (the Contract for Differences) if the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") does not issue certain guidance (the Related Party Guidance) prior to the date the Crossroads Project goes into commercial operation, or if the Related Party Guidance is not received with sufficient time to execute the BTA PPA.

If the Contract for Differences is approved and is used instead of the BTA PPA or the Back-Stop PPA, NIPSCO would recover its payments made to Crossroads ProjectCo pursuant to the Contract for Differences through the Fuel Adjustment Clause without regard to Ind. Code § 8-1-2-42(d)(1) through (4) and without regard to any benchmarks established by the Commission for PPAs, the same approval the Commission granted for the BTA PPA and the Back-Stop PPA.²

5. **Alternative Regulatory Plan.** Pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1-2.5-6, NIPSCO may propose alternative regulatory practices, procedures and mechanisms. NIPSCO elects to become subject to Ind. Code § 8-1-2.5-6. In this filing, NIPSCO is proposing an amendment to Ordering Paragraph 6 of the Commission's 45310 Order to modify its approved alternative regulatory plan to include the Contract for Differences as a possible component of the Joint Venture structure.

6. **Applicable Law.** Joint Petitioners consider the provisions of the Public Service Commission Act, as amended, may be applicable to this proceeding, including Ind. Code §§ 8-1-2-42(a), 72, 79, 80, 8-1-2.5-5, and 6, 8-1-8.5-4, 5, 6, and 8-1-8.8-11, among others.

² The 45310 Order approved NIPSCO's request to recover its payments made to Crossroads ProjectCo pursuant to the BTA PPA and the Back-Stop PPA through the Fuel Adjustment Clause without regard to Ind. Code § 8-1-2-42(d)(1) through (4) and without regard to any benchmarks established by the Commission for PPAs as an alternative regulatory plan.

7. **Confidentiality Request.** Joint Petitioners requests confidential treatment of the pricing and other negotiated commercial terms and related confidential, proprietary and competitively sensitive information, since that information is properly considered “trade secrets” under Ind. Code § 5-14-3-4(a)(4). A separate motion under 170 IAC 1-1.1-4 is being filed in this Cause to make this request.

9. **Request for Prehearing Conference and Preliminary Hearing.** In accordance with 170 IAC 1-1.1-15(b) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure and GAO-2013-5, NIPSCO requests that a prehearing conference and preliminary hearing be promptly set by the Commission as soon as practical for the purpose of addressing procedural matters including setting a procedural schedule in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Joint Petitioners Northern Indiana Public Service Company LLC and Indiana Crossroads Wind Generation LLC request that the Commission promptly

publish notice, make such other investigation, and hold such hearings as are necessary or advisable and thereafter, make and enter appropriate orders in this Cause:

(a) Amending Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 to include the Contract for Differences as also being a component of the previously approved clean energy project under Ind. Code § 8-1-8.8.3, and being reasonable and necessary under Ind. Code § 8-1-8.8-11;


(b) Amending Ordering Paragraph 4 authorizing NIPSCO to recover its payments made to Crossroads ProjectCo pursuant to the Contract for Differences in addition to the previously-approved BTA PPA and the Back-Stop PPA, through the Fuel Adjustment Charge without regard to Ind. Code § 8-1-2-42(d)(1) through (4) and without regard to any benchmarks established by the Commission for PPAs;

(c) Amending Ordering Paragraph 6 to modify its approved alternative regulatory plan to include the Contract for Differences as a possible component of the Joint Venture structure; and

(d) Making such further orders and providing such further relief to Joint Petitioners as may be appropriate.


