## INDIANA CROSSROADS WIND FARM LLC'S 4th QUARTER 2021 REPORT

This 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2021 Report (this "Report") is filed as required by the Commission's Order in this Cause issued on March 18, 2020, in Cause No. 45320. The Order requires Indiana Crossroads Wind Farm LLC ("Petitioner" or "Indiana Crossroads") to file quarterly reports within 30 days of the end of each quarter during the period prior to achieving commercial operation. This Report provides the required information to the extent such information is known and available. The requested information is as follows:

#### (1) Any changes of the information provided in the Initial Report.

No changes to the Initial Report occurred during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2021. Indiana Crossroads notes that it filed its Notice of Transfer on December 17, 2021, and within one business day after its membership interests were transferred to the joint venture entity with Northern Indiana Public Service Company, LLC, as required in the Order. Indiana Crossroads further states that because commercial operation has been achieved, this is the final quarterly report that will be filed and future reports will be made on an annual basis in accordance with the terms of the Order issued in this Cause.

# (2) Any reports of Interconnection System Impact Studies not previously submitted to the Commission.

All Interconnection System Impact Studies have previously been submitted to the Commission. (See testimony of Ryan J. Brown, Petitioner's <u>Attachment RJB-3</u>).

# (3) Copy of the GIA as filed with FERC.

A copy of the GIA as filed with FERC has previously been submitted to the Commission. (See testimony of Ryan J. Brown, Petitioner's <u>Attachment RJB-4</u>).

# (4) Notice of the establishment of an independent financial instrument, including its form and amount.

Petitioner has executed a Road Use and Drainage Crossing Agreement and a Decommissioning Agreement with White County. In connection with said agreements, Indiana Crossroads has established a \$5,000,000.00 Road Use Performance Bond and \$3,916,500.00 Decommissioning Bond with White County as the benefactor. Petitioner also established an irrevocable standby letter of credit for \$4,970,286 as of September 30, 2019 for the GIA with MISO and Northern Indiana Public Service Company, LLC. The letter of credit was released by Northern Indiana Public Service Company, LLC, following completion of their interconnection construction activities.

(5) Achievement of construction milestones described in the Generator Interconnection Agreement and such events as the procurement of major equipment, the receipt of major permits material to the construction and operation of the Facility, construction start-up, initial energization, and commercial operation.

(6) When commercial operation is achieved, the nameplate capacity, term, and identity of a purchaser for any contracts then existing for utility sales, contingency plans (if any) detailing response plans to emergency conditions as required by state or local units of government, the interconnecting transmission owner and/or MISO, and the Facility's certified (or accredited) dependable capacity rating.

The nameplate capacity for Indiana Crossroads is 302.4 MW. Indiana Crossroads has executed a power purchase agreement ("PPA") with Northern Indiana Public Service Company, LLC. The PPA is for 100% of the facility's generation capacity with a term of 15 years, with delivery under the PPA commencing on December 17, 2021. No state or local units of government require contingency plans detailing response plans to emergency conditions. The interconnecting transmission owner is Northern Indiana Public Service Company, LLC, and Indiana Crossroads' certified dependable capacity rating is 300.1 MW.
