PETITION TO INTERVENE OF THE
CITY OF AUBURN ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT

The City of Auburn Electric Department (“Auburn”), by counsel, and pursuant to 170 IAC 1-1.1-11, respectfully petitions the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) for leave to intervene and participate as a party in this proceeding. In support of this Petition to Intervene, Auburn states:

1. The City of Auburn is a municipality located in DeKalb County, Indiana.
2. Auburn owns and operates a municipal electric utility which serves approximately 7,700 residential, commercial and industrial customers in and around the City of Auburn.
3. On May 14, 2019, Indiana Michigan Power Company (“I&M”) filed its petition requesting authority from the Commission to increase its rates and charges for electric service and for other relief as set forth in the caption.

4. Auburn purchases all of its electricity for resale from I&M. Auburn's participation in this Cause is required to allow it to determine the extent to which the issues herein will impact the rates paid by Auburn to I&M. Auburn has a substantial interest in this proceeding.

5. Auburn's interests are not represented by any other party in this proceeding.

6. Auburn's intervention will not unduly broaden the issues pending before the Commission in this proceeding or result in unreasonable delay thereof.

7. The names and addresses of Auburn's attorneys, who are authorized to accept service of all pleadings and papers in this Cause, are:
