You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On March 11, 2025, the City of Anderson, Indiana ("Petitioner") filed an Unopposed Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule ("Motion"). Petitioner indicates that due to scheduling conflicts, the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor ("OUCC") and Petitioner have agreed the procedural schedule in this Cause should be modified.

The Presiding Officers, having considered the Motion, amend the procedural schedule as follows:

1. <u>OUCC and Intervenors' Prefiling Date</u>. The OUCC and all Intervenors shall prefile with the Commission the prepared testimony and exhibits constituting their respective cases-in-chief on or before April 3, 2025. Copies of same shall be served upon all parties of record.

2. <u>Petitioner's Rebuttal Prefiling Date</u>. Petitioner shall prefile with the Commission its prepared rebuttal testimony on or before April 30, 2025. Copies of same shall be served upon all parties of record.

3. <u>Evidentiary Hearing</u>. In the event this Cause is not settled, the cases-in-chief of Petitioner, the OUCC, and any Intervenors shall be presented in an evidentiary hearing to commence at 10:30 a.m. on May 21, 2025, in Room 222 of the PNC Center, 101 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana. At such time, the direct evidence of the respective parties shall be presented and their respective witnesses examined. Thereafter, Petitioner shall present its prefiled rebuttal evidence as well as any additional evidence rebutting evidence adduced on cross-examination of the OUCC's or Intervenors' witnesses. If the parties reach settlement, the agreement and supporting testimony and exhibits shall be submitted to the Commission ten business days prior to the evidentiary hearing.

4. <u>Post-Hearing Filings</u>. Petitioner shall file its proposed order on or before June 16, 2025. The OUCC and Intervenors shall file their respective proposed orders and/or any exceptions to Petitioner's proposed order on or before July 9, 2025. Petitioner shall file any reply to the OUCC's and/or Intervenor's proposed orders and/or exceptions on or before July 15, 2025.

All other procedural requirements remain as established in the Commission's January 22, 2025 docket entry.
