On March 16, 2022, Indiana House Enrolled Act 1002 was signed into law, removing the Utility Receipts Tax from utility bills beginning on July 1, 2022. This results in approximately a 1.4% reduction in your monthly Sycamore Gas bill. This reduction will affect all General Service residential, commercial, and industrial customers, as well as Gas Transportation customers that currently are charged rates that include the Utility Receipts tax. Sycamore Gas will be completing a 30-day filing with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission, to be filed on April 29, 2022, asking for approval of new tariffs reflecting this reduction. On March 16, 2022, Indiana House Enrolled Act 1002 was signed into law, removing the Utility Receipts Tax from utility bills for usage beginning July 1, 2022. Removing this tax is estimated to reduce your monthly gas bill by approximately 1.4%. For a typical residential customer, this means an approximate savings of \$14.11 per year.
