You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On May 25, 2017, Sugar Creek Packing Company ("Sugar Creek") filed a Complaint in this Cause requesting the Commission review Western Wayne Regional Sewage District's ("WWRSD") operations associated with providing service to customers, including Sugar Creek.

Having reviewed the prefiled testimony of Martin Wessler, the Presiding Officers request WWRSD respond to the questions below on or before 12 o'clock noon on Monday, September 18, 2017:

- 1. Please describe the process WWRSD utilizes to account for both treatment and conveyance capacity when considering capacity certification requests.
 - (a) Does WWRSD maintain an accounting of its treatment capacity? If yes, please provide that accounting.
 - (b) Was a calculation performed of the conveyance capacity prior to the certification being made? If so, please provide that calculation.
- 2. With respect to the ISCO flow meters referenced on page 22, lines 4-6 of Mr. Wessler's prefiled testimony, does the meter utilize an ultra-sonic

or pressure sensor (or both) to measure flow depth? How often are the velocity and level sensors of the flow meters scrubbed and calibrated?

3. Since January 1, 2017, what overflows from the Gateway Industrial Park lift station has Sugar Creek reported to the Indiana Department of Environmental Management ("IDEM")? Are you aware of any overflows from the Gateway Industrial Park since January 1, 2017, that have not been reported to IDEM? If yes, please describe these, including when each occurred.
