Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of Dearborn County, Indiana, that the Dearborn County Commissioners will hold a Public Hearing in the Henry Dearborn meeting room of the Dearborn County Government Center, 165 Mary Street, Lawrenceburg, Indiana, at 5:00 p.m. on March 16, 2021, to consider the reestablishment of the rate of the Cumulative Capital Development Fund under the provisions of Indiana Code 6-1-1-41 and Indiana Code 36-9-1-4.5 for any and all uses as set out in IC 36-9-1-4.5.
