PETITIONER'S SUBMISSION OF UPDATED PHASE II RATES AND TARIFFS

Petitioner Community Utilities of Indiana, Inc. ("Petitioner" or "CUII"), by counsel, hereby submits the following information in accordance with the direction provided by the Presiding Administrative Law Judge's June 5, 2024 email to counsel:

- Please see attached Excel files labeled "Attendant Expense Update (sewer)" and "Attendant Expense Update (water)" for updated wastewater and water revenue requirements that reflect removal of the forecasted \$5 million investment in wastewater infrastructure and "all attendant expenses". Please see tab labeled "Comparison of Updates" for a description of the changes made. In addition, for the water tariff, please see tab labeled "Sch.G-Water Rate Design" showing a correction to use the approved base charge for 1-inch meters.

- Please see attached file labeled “Water Rate Base – IFR Retirement” that shows an updated rate base calculation reflecting the Iron Filter Replacement retirement as recommended by the OUCC.
- Please see attached clean and redline tariffs reflecting the revised Phase II rates for both water and wastewater.
- Please see attached Excel file labeled “Attendant Expense Update – Sewer Refunding” showing the corrections to be made based on bills through May 31, 2024. To ensure customers are fully refunded the difference in rates, CUII will calculate the same refunding through the effective date of rates from this update, which will result in a second set of refunding from June 1st through the effective date of approval of these revised rates.

Petitioner respectfully requests prompt review and approval of the attached tariff sheets so as to allow Petitioner to recalculate bills and efficiently administer refunds. Petitioner asks that a copy of the stamped tariffs be returned to undersigned counsel.
