NOTICE OF REDUCTION IN FOUNTAINTOWN GAS RATES DUE TO THE REPEAL OF THE INDIANA UTILITY RECEIPTS TAX.

On March 16, 2022, Indiana House Enrolled Act 1002 was signed into law, removing the Utility Receipts Tax from utility bills for usage beginning July 1, 2022. Removing this tax is estimated to reduce your monthly gas bill by approximately 1.4%. For a typical residential customer, this means an approximate savings of \$10.68 per year. FOUNTAINTOWN anticipates filing its revised tariff sheets reflecting this rate reduction on or before May 1, 2022, with rates excluding the Indiana Utility Receipts Tax first going into effect on gas customers' July 2022 bills.
