You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On May 9, 2019, the NIPSCO Industrial Group, on behalf of Northern Indiana Public Service Company LLC, Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor, United States Steel Corporation, and NLMK Indiana ("Joint Movants") filed its Joint Unopposed Motion to Extend the Prefiling Dates Regarding the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement on Less Than All the Issues ("Motion") in the above-captioned Cause. In the Motion, Joint Movants request a modification of the procedural schedule in this case to extend the prefiling dates for evidence related to the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement on Less than All the Issues ("Settlement Agreement") by approximately one week. Specifically, Joint Movants request that the Settling Parties' Prefiling Date be extended from May 10, 2019, to May 17, 2019, the Non-Settling Parties' Responsive Prefiling Date be extended from May 31, 2019, to June 7, 2019, and the Settling Parties' Reply Prefiling Date be extended from June 14, 2019, to June 18, 2019. Joint Movants further request that all other dates in the Commission's May 1, 2019 Docket Entry remain unchanged, including the start of the evidentiary hearing on July 16, 2019. Joint Movants also state that all parties have been notified about the Motion, and none have indicated an intent to object.

The Presiding Officers, having reviewed the Motion, now GRANT the Motion. The Settling Parties shall prefile their prepared testimony and exhibits supporting the Settlement Agreement on or before May 17, 2019. The Non-Settling Parties' shall prefile their prepared testimony and exhibits responding to the Settlement Agreement and supporting testimony on or before June 7, 2019. The Settling Parties shall prefile their prepared reply testimony and exhibits

on or before June 18, 2019. All other dates and procedures shall remain as established in the May 1, 2019 Docket Entry in this Cause.
