**PETITIONER’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL CONTINUANCE**

Petitioner Southern Indiana Gas & Electric Company d/b/a CenterPoint Energy Indiana South (“CEI South”) moves to further continue the commencement of the evidentiary hearing in order to permit continued settlement discussions.

The evidentiary hearing in this Cause is presently scheduled to commence May 10, 2024 and to continue on May 14, May 17, May 28 and May 29. Certain of the parties have been engaged

in settlement discussions and those negotiations have progressed to the point of an agreement in principle among less than all the parties on less than all the issues. At least some of the parties, including CEI South, believe that additional time is needed so that at least some of the parties can continue efforts to enter a comprehensive settlement agreement. Petitioner requests that the hearing date of May 10, 2024 be continued to allow settlement discussions to continue and that the dates reserved for hearing be extended to the next available date on the Commission's calendar after the currently scheduled May 29, 2024 hearing date to allow for an additional day of hearing. If settlement cannot be achieved, then the hearing would commence on the May 14, 2024 date.

Petitioner represents that it has conferred with all of the other parties to this Cause and can represent that they do not object to this Motion.
