<u>JOINT VERIFIED STATUS REPORT AND REQUEST TO CONTINUE STAY TO</u> <u>ALLOW FOR CONSIDERATION OF A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BY THE</u> <u>INDIANA UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION</u>

Appellant, the NIPSCO Industrial Group, ("Industrial Group"), and Appellee,

Northern Indiana Public Service Co., ("NIPSCO"), by counsel, pursuant to Indiana

Appellate Rule 39, hereby jointly file this Joint Verified Status Report and Request to

Continue the Stay in order to allow the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission

("Commission") sufficient time to consider, and issue an order regarding, a settlement

agreement between and among the Industrial Group, NIPSCO and the Indiana Office of

Industrial Group and NIPSCO's Joint Verified Status Report and Request to Continue Stay

Utility Consumer Counselor ("OUCC") in the underlying case. In support of this Motion, the Industrial Group and NIPSCO state as follows:

- This is a petition for judicial review from a final order of the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Cause No. 44403-TDSIC-7, issued on December 28, 2017.
- This appeal, and Cause Nos. 93A02-1701-EX-177, 19302-1704-EX-01632, and 18A-EX-2281 all involve issues addressed in the Indiana Supreme Court's recent decision in <u>NIPSCO Industrial Group v. Northern Indiana Public Service Co.</u>, 100 N.E.3d 234 (Ind. 2018).
- 3. Following the issuance of the Supreme Court's decision, the Industrial Group, NIPSCO and the OUCC (collectively "Settling Parties") entered into settlement discussions to effectuate the relief required by the Supreme Court's decision and resolve the remaining issues that separate the parties in this appeal and the appeals identified in Paragraph 2, above.
- 4. On November 2, 2018, the Industrial Group and NIPSCO filed a Joint Verified Motion for Stay in this Cause and Cause Nos. 93A02-1701-EX-177and 93A02-1707-EX-01632 notifying the Court the Settling Parties had reached an agreement in principle and asking for a stay to allow finalization of the agreement and its consideration by the Commission. That request was granted in part by an Order dated November 9, 2018, giving the Industrial Group thirty (30) days to file a motion to dismiss the appeal or a status report on the status of negotiations.

- 5. On December 10, 2018, in accordance with the Court's November 9th Order, the Industrial Group and NIPSCO filed a Joint Verified Status Report and Request to Continue the Stay noting the filing of the settlement and supporting testimony, and that an evidentiary hearing on the settlement had been held on November 29, 2018.
- 6. By Order dated December 13, 2018, the Court granted the Joint Verified Status Report and Request to Continue the Stay, directing that "[n]o later than December 26, 2018" the Industrial Group should move to dismiss the proceedings or file "a status report regarding settlement."
- 7. The Commission has placed the proceeding in which the settlement is being considered on its weekly agenda for December 27, 2018, meaning a final order regarding the settlement is expected to issue that day.
- Approval of the settlement by the Commission, without substantial change, would obviate the need for the Court to issue an opinion in this appeal as well as Cause Nos. 93A02-1701-EX-177, 93A02-1707-EX-01632, and 18A-EX-2281.
- 9. The Industrial Group and NIPSCO therefore submit that it is appropriate to continue the stay of this proceeding, and the other related appeals, to afford the Commission the opportunity to issue its final order on the settlement, and to allow the parties to review the order.
- Counsel for the Industrial Group is authorized to represent to the Court that NIPSCO has provided the authority to submit this joint filing.

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Industrial Group and NIPSCO's Joint Verified Status Report and Request to Continue Stay

WHEREFORE, the NIPSCO Industrial Group and Northern Indiana Public Service Co., jointly and respectfully request a stay of this and all related appeals through and including January 9, 2019 at which time the Industrial Group and NIPSCO will either move to dismiss the appeal, or request the Court take such other steps as may be appropriate.
