You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On October 2, 2020, the City of Richmond, Indiana, by and through its municipal electric utility, Richmond Power and Light ("Richmond" or "Petitioner"), on behalf of itself and the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor ("OUCC"), filed its Verified Joint Motion to Reopen the Record and Request for Leave to Submit Petitioner's Supplemental Settlement Testimony ("Motion"). The parties have requested to reopen the record to permit Petitioner to submit supplemental settlement testimony regarding LED lighting rates due to errors in Petitioner's original settlement evidence on this topic. The proposed supplemental settlement testimony was attached to the Motion.

After reviewing the Motion, the Presiding Officers GRANT the Motion. Petitioner's supplemental settlement testimony that was attached to the Motion is considered filed with the Commission as of October 2, 2020.

The Commission will reopen the record in this Cause and hold a hearing on October 21, 2020 at 2:30 p.m. to receive Petitioner's supplemental settlement testimony into the record. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the hearing will take place via WebEx, with further details listed below.

1. <u>Telephonic Hearing</u>. Those directly participating in the hearing shall join the WebEx teleconference by video using information that will be provided via email. Anyone not directly participating in the hearing, including interested members of the public, must call 1-240-454-0887, and, when prompted, enter the access code 172 710 8249, followed by the pound key, in order to listen to the hearing.

2. <u>Exhibits</u>. Each party shall e-mail the Presiding Administrative Law Judge and the other parties with a list of the exhibits the party intends to offer into evidence at the hearing no later than 24 hours before the scheduled time of the evidentiary hearing. If a party intends to offer

an exhibit that has not yet been prefiled or an exhibit containing corrections or revisions not yet prefiled, the party shall also prefile that exhibit with the Commission no later than 24 hours before the hearing. The parties shall mail hard copies of their exhibits to the Commission within 30 days of the hearing date.
