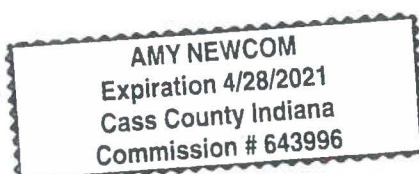



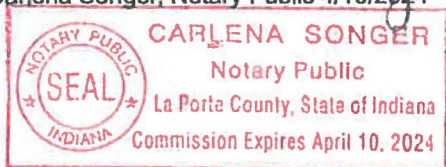

## DOG AND CAT CONTROL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the citizens of the Town of Moores Hill, Indiana, in the interests of their safety and wellbeing wish to prohibit the free wandering of dogs and/or cats on the public streets, sidewalks, public places and on the private property of local citizens.

## SECTION I - Definitions

For the purpose of this ordinance, the following definitions shall prevail:

Animal - Dog or cat.

At large - A dog or cat off the property of the owner and not under restraint.

Humane manner - Care of an animal including, but not limited to, adequate heat, ventilation, sanitary shelter, wholesome food, and water consistent with the normal requirements and feeding habits of the animal's size, species, and breed.

Kennel - An establishment kept for the purpose of breeding, selling, or boarding dogs or cats.

Neutered - Rendered permanently incapable of reproduction.

D. Disposal of an animal by any method specified herein does not relieve the owner of liability for violations and any accrued charges.

## Section V - Redemption

A. Any animal impounded may be redeemed by the owner thereof within five days upon payment of an impoundment fee of \$25.00; if any such animal has been previously impounded, the impoundment fee shall be \$100.00. Payment of impoundment fees is not considered to be in lieu of any fine, penalty, or license fees.

B. Any animal confined for rabies quarantine, evidence, or other purpose may be redeemed by the owner thereof upon payment of a fee of \$150.00.

C. No animal required to be vaccinated under this ordinance may be redeemed until provisions for such licensing have been fulfilled.

## Section VI - Adoption

An adoption fee of (see below) shall be assessed at the time of adoption. No dog or cat shall be released for adoption as a pet without being neutered or without a written agreement from the adopter guaranteeing that the animal will be neutered.

Vaccination fees, licensing fees, and veterinary costs may be assessed above and beyond the adoption fee.

- Dogs \$75.00 over 1 year old
- Puppies \$150.00 under 1 year old
- Cats \$25.00 over 6 months old
- Kittens \$50.00 under 6 months old

## Section VII - Repeals (Conflicting Ordinances)

All other ordinances of the Town of Moores Hill that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

## Section XIII - Applicability

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of 7 days after its passage and publication.

Nuisance - A dog or cat that damages, soils, defiles, or defecates on private property other than the owner's or on public walks and recreation areas unless such waste is immediately removed and properly disposed of by the owner; causes unsanitary, dangerous, or offensive conditions; causes a disturbance by excessive barking or other noise making; or chases vehicles or molests, attacks, or interferes with persons or other domestic animals on public property.

Owner - A person having the right of property or custody of a dog or cat that keeps or harbors a dog or cat or knowingly permits a dog or cat to remain on or about any premises occupied by that person.

Under restraint - A dog or cat within the real property limits of its owner, secured by a leash or lead, or under the control of a responsible person.

Dangerous - A dog or cat that without justification attacks a person or domestic animal causing physical injury or death or that behaves in a manner that a reasonable person would believe poses an unjustified imminent threat of serious injury or death to one or more persons or domestic animals.

## Section II - Rabies Vaccination

- No person shall own, keep, or harbor any dog or cat over 4 months of age within the Town of Moores Hill unless such dog or cat is vaccinated.
- All dogs and cats shall be vaccinated against rabies by a licensed veterinarian in accordance with the most recent version of the Compendium of Animal Rabies Prevention and Control, authorized by the National Association of State Public Health Veterinarians.
- A certificate of vaccination shall be issued to the owner of each animal vaccinated on a form recommended by the Compendium. Each owner shall also receive a durable vaccination tag indicating the year in which it was issued.
- Rabies tags must be attached to the collar of the dog or cat. Tags must be worn at all times and are not transferable.

## Section III - Owner Responsibility

- All dogs and cats shall be kept under restraint.
- Every dangerous dog or cat, as determined by the Town of Moores Hill, shall be confined by its owner within a building or secure enclosure and shall be securely muzzled or caged whenever off the premises of its owner.
- No dog or cat shall be allowed to cause a nuisance. The owner of every dog or cat shall be held responsible for every behavior of such dog or cat under the provisions of this ordinance.
- Persons who fail to comply with the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense, and then One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for the second offense.
- Dog and cat owners shall ensure that their dog or cat carried identification at all times in the form of microchip, tag, or other means to allow easy determination of the owners.

## Section IV - Impoundment

- Any dog or cat found at large shall be impounded by the Dearborn County Animal Control Authority and confined in a humane manner. Immediately upon impounding a dog or cat, the Animal Control Authority shall make every reasonable effort to notify the owner and inform such owner of the conditions whereby custody of the animal may be regained. Dogs and cats not claimed by their owners within a period of 5 full days in which the shelter is open to the public shall become the property of the Animal Control Authority.
- When a dog or cat is found running at large and its ownership is verified by the Town of Moores Hill, the authority may exercise the option of serving the owner with a notice of violation in lieu of impounding the animal.
- In the event that the Town of Moores Hill finds dogs or cats to be suffering, it shall have the right to notify the Dearborn County Animal Control, forthwith to remove or cause to have removed any such animals to a safe place for care at the owner's expense to prevent further suffering. Return to the owner may be withheld until the owner has made full payment for all expenses so incurred to the Town of Moores Hill and the Dearborn County Animal Control.

## Section XIII - Safety Clause

The Town of Moores Hill Town Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the Town of Moores Hill and the inhabitants thereof.

When any person commits any of the acts or causes any of the conditions, a complaining person should take a picture of the dog or cat in violation and turn the picture to the president of the Moores Hill Town Board. The President of the Town Board will then turn the picture over to the Moores Hill Town Marshall who will then be directed to contact the Dearborn County Animal Control to help assist with capture of the dog and sent to the county animal shelter. Cats are to be handled in the discretion of the Moores Hill Town Marshall and violations will be served.

It is recognized that holding periods will be determined to some degree by availability of facilities; however, it is important to ensure a reasonable opportunity for owners to reclaim their dog or cat.

## Power posturing for ladder-climbing bosses

Do you want to hit the fast-forward button on your career? Do you want to collect underlings like baseball cards? If so, I suggest adopting a few fundamental power postures. This is all about making yourself look as big as possible. Wear as many jackets as possible; you'll be sweaty, but your co-workers will fear you. Also, stand like you're trying to scare away a bear in the forest.

My favorite power posture takes some work. Before anyone else gets into the office, make everyone else's chair shorter than yours so you'll look like a giant. It may take some MacGyver ingenuity to accomplish this, but you're destined for greatness. Do what it takes to literally rise above everyone else. Before you know it, they'll all be your subordinates.

Just like it's essential to view everyone at work as a subordinate, it's also crucial to recognize a subordinate sentence clause when you see one. A subordinate, or dependent clause, is a clause that can't stand alone as a sentence, but it adds meaning to a sentence's main clause. The main clause, which is independent, can stand on its own. How about some examples?

I am going to work this morning.

This sentence stands on its own; however, that's not all the information or meaning I intend to convey. Allow me to introduce a subordinate clause:

I am going to work this morning if I can find my keys.

In this sentence, "if I can find my keys" not only doesn't stand alone as a sentence, but it adds some important additional information into the sentence. This clause is a subordinate clause.

The word that introduces the subordinate clause itself is called a subordinator, which sounds like some kind of underwater Terminator knock-off movie. Common subordinators include because, since, if, although, while, before, after, unless and until. If your subordinate clause begins your sentence, always add a comma after the clause. Becoming familiar with these subordinators will make it easy for you to recognize subordinate clauses.

If you want that six-figure check, you're going to have to tower over the mere mortal coworkers who either want to be you or date you. Just like subordinate

clauses, they can't stand on their own apart from the proximity of your sheer awesomeness. Before you know it, they'll be re-naming all the Forbes lists after you.
