AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAWRENCEBURG AND THE TOWN OF MOORES HILL RELATING TO MOORES HILL'S USE OF THE LAWRENCEBURG CITY COURT FOR ORDINANCE VIOLATION HEARINGS

THIS AGREEMENT by and between the City of Lawrenceburg ("Lawrenceburg") and the Town of Moores Hill ("Moores Hill"), in the County of Dearborn, State of Indiana, (collectively the Parties"), is dated this 1st day of May, 2018.

WHEREAS, Lawrenceburg operates a City Court established pursuant to Title 33, Article 35 of the Indiana Code; and

WHEREAS, Lawrenceburg maintains the City Court, which they are willing to make available for Moores Hill's use to conduct Ordinance Violation matters and any other similar proceedings in Lawrenceburg's City Court; and

WHEREAS, Moores Hill's use of the Lawrenceburg's City Court will provide Moores Hill with a venue to conduct Ordinance Violation matters, a sworn Judge/Hearing Officer, a Prosecutor, Court staff, a Collections Agency, the processing of payment, and access to Court-provided administrative services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to enter into an interlocal agreement to set for the terms and conditions relating to Moores Hill's use of Lawrenceburg's City Court facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, I.C. 37-1-7-2 allows for political subdivisions to jointly exercise powers granted to each of them.

NOW, THEREFORE, Moores Hill and Lawrenceburg have entered into this interlocal agreement in consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived under the Agreement.

AGREEMENT

1. Moores Hill shall file all ordinance violations and infractions in the Lawrenceburg City Court for adjudication. These violations shall include but not be limited to traffic and zoning violations written on Moores Hill Ordinances.

2. Moores Hill shall be responsible for the prosecution of all Moores Hill cases. However, Moores Hill may elect to have Lawrenceburg prosecute Moores Hill cases and Lawrenceburg agrees to do so upon request. Moores Hill agrees to hold Lawrenceburg harmless for all such prosecution, court proceedings and subsequent collection and enforcement activity. In the event that the City Attorney of either jurisdiction has a conflict representing their respective City, the other party's City Attorney shall assume that representation without compensation.
