## **UNOPPOSED MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE (Phase 2)**

Petitioner Jackson County Water Utility, Inc. ("Jackson County", or "Petitioner"), by counsel and in accordance with 170 IAC 1-1.1-15(e), respectfully moves the Commission to modify the procedural schedule. In support of this Unopposed Motion, Petitioner state as follows:

- 1. By docket entry dated May 12, 2022, the Commission established a procedural schedule for Phase 2.
- 2. Despite due diligence, Jackson County has been unable to close on the financing authorized by the Commission in the Phase 1 Order approved April 27, 2022. Therefore, Jackson County requests the procedural schedule be modified as follows to allow additional time for closing:
  - a. <u>Jackson County Prefiling Date</u>: Jackson County will file prepared testimony and attachments constituting its Phase 2 case-in-chief on or before August 19, 2022.
  - b. OUCC and Intervenors Phase 1 Prefiling Date: The OUCC and any Intervenors should prefile with the Commission the prepared testimony and attachments constituting their respective Phase 2 cases-in-chief on or before November 18, 2022. Copies of same should be served upon all parties of record.
  - c. <u>Jackson County Phase 2 Rebuttal Prefiling</u>: Jackson County should prefile with the Commission its prepared Phase 2 rebuttal testimony on or before December 19, 2022. Copies of same should be served upon all parties of record.

- d. Evidentiary Hearing. Petitioner requests that the evidentiary hearing in this Cause be set for one day on February 7, 8, 9, or 10, 2023. In the event that these days are not available on the Commission's calendar, the Parties request the Commission fix the date for a one day evidentiary hearing as soon as possible thereafter, and if necessary convene an attorneys' conference via telephone so that the Parties may discuss a mutually agreeable date.
- 3. Jackson County conferred with the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor ("OUCC") and is authorized to represent that the OUCC agrees to the proposed dates and does not oppose this motion.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Jackson County respectfully requests that the Commission:

- 1. Modify the procedural schedule in Phase 2, as set forth above; and
- 2. Grant such other and further relief to Jackson County as the Commission may deem proper.
