MEADOW LAKE WIND FARM VI LLC'S INITIAL QUARTERLY REPORT

This Initial Quarterly Report (this "Report") is filed as required by the Commission's Order in this Cause issued on February 28, 2018, in Cause No. 45010. This Report provides the required information to the extent such information is known and available. The requested information is as follows:

(1) Project ownership and name(s) of the Facility.

The owner of the project is Meadow Lake Wind Farm VI LLC ("Meadow Lake"). The name of the facility is Meadow Lake Wind Farm Phase VI.

(2) Name, title, address, and phone number(s) for primary contact person(s) for the Facility.

(3) Number and location of wind turbines deployed.

Meadow Lake has not yet installed any wind turbines at the project site. The Meadow Lake Wind Farm Phase VI will have 61 wind turbines.

(4) Anticipated total output of the Facility.

The anticipated output of the Meadow Lake Wind Farm is 200.4 MW.

(5) Manufacturer, model number and operational characteristics of turbines.

The Meadow Lake Wind Farm Phase VI will use 49 Vestas V136 3.6 MW turbines and 12 Vestas V110 2.0 MW turbines.

(6) Connecting utility(s).

The connecting utility will be AEP.

(7) Copy of any Interconnection System Impact Studies prepared by PJM.

The Feasibility Study performed by PJM was attached to the testimony of Ryan J. Brown as Petitioner's Attachment RJB-4. PJM performed a System Impact Study, which was attached to the testimony of Ryan J. Brown as Petitioner's Attachment RJB-5.

(8) Expected in-service (commercial operation) date.

The expected commercial operation date is December 31, 2018.

(9) An estimate of the engineering/construction timeline and critical milestones for the Facility.

An estimate of the engineering/construction timeline and critical milestones for the Facility are set forth below:

Start of construction: March 15, 2018

Collection system completion: September 17, 2018

Project transmission line and substation completion: September 28, 2018

Turbine mechanical completion: October 18, 2018

Project commercial operation: December 31, 2018

(10) The status of the ISA with PJM.

Meadow Lake has not yet entered into an Interconnection Service Agreement with PJM. Meadow Lake anticipates finalizing the Interconnection Service Agreement with PJM by the end of April 2018.

Meadow Lake has not yet entered into an Interconnection Service Agreement. Meadow Lake anticipates finalizing the Interconnection Service Agreement with PJM by the end of April 2018.

This has not been established yet.

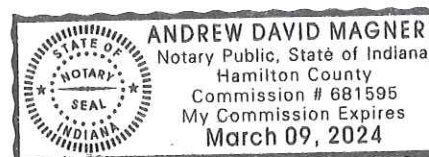


