You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) has caused the following entry to be made:

On June 6, 2023, the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor (“OUCC”) filed a Request For Second Field Hearing (“Motion”) in the above-captioned Cause. In its Motion, the OUCC states that Indiana-American Water Company, Inc. (“Indiana-American”) serves a significant number of customers within and near northwest Indiana and that the Commission has historically held more than one field hearing in Indiana-American’s rate cases. The OUCC requests a field hearing be conducted in northwest Indiana to allow Indiana-American’s customers located in northwest Indiana to submit evidence regarding the relief requested in this Cause.¹ The OUCC further indicates that there are no objections to the Motion.

The Presiding Officers, having considered the matter, GRANT the OUCC’s Motion. A second public field hearing is scheduled as follows:
