In this proceeding, Vectren South seeks approval of its 7-year electric TDSIC plan for eligible transmission, distribution and storage system improvements, for authority to defer costs for future recovery, and approving inclusion of Vectren South's TDSIC plan projects in its rate case in its next general rate proceeding, among other things.
- 6. CAC and VW include among their members numerous individuals and families who are residential retail customers of Vectren and have a substantial interest in the proceeding. They pay Vectren rates and charges for residential electric service, which will be impacted by this proceeding. They also are dependent upon Vectren facilities, equipment and personnel for the reliability of their electric service. Therefore, the members of CAC and VW will be affected by any approval of cost increases to be recovered, even if recovery is deferred. In addition, the members of CAC and VW will be impacted by any Commission findings that impact future resource choices. CAC and VW therefore have a substantial interest in this proceeding.
- 7. CAC and VW have regularly appeared on behalf of their members before the Commission in numerous proceedings and no other party can adequately represent the substantial interests of their members.
- 8. The addition of CAC and VW as parties to this Cause will not unduly broaden the issues or otherwise burden the proceedings. CAC and VW understand that they are bound by the record as it stands at the time their Petition to Intervene is granted.
