INDIANA-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY, INC.'S SUBMISSION OF REPORT ON COVID RESPONSE ACTIVITIES

Pursuant to the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's June 29, 2020 order in Cause No.

45380¹, Indiana-America Water Company, Inc., ("Indiana American" or "INAW"), by counsel, hereby submits its report describing recent COVID response activities.

As stated in its Petition to Intervene, dated June 10, 2020, "Indiana-American continues to focus on two major priorities—the health and safety of its employees and its customers."²

Indiana American Water has filed multiple reports updating and describing recent COVID response activities thus far. In the latest report, filed December 22, 2021, data for receivables and installment plans were as of November 30, 2021. Please refer to those prior submissions for the background and recent activities as well as Indiana American's targeted customer assistance programs to help its most vulnerable customers.

Additional items requested in Commission's May 27, 2020 Order

The Commission's May 27, 2020 Order in Cause No. 45380 provided a list of 17 items requested of "the Joint Utility Petitioners and any jurisdictional Indiana utility intending to participate in this proceeding and request rate relief." By the terms of the May 27, 2020 Order, Indiana American was not required to provide this information, particularly in light of Indiana American's intention not to participate in the rate relief phase of this proceeding. The Commission had declined to extend the additional reporting requirements to parties not seeking rate relief in this proceeding, and Indiana American has complied with the Commission's Orders in this docket.

Pursuant to the Commission's Order dated August 25, 2021, and because we believe enough time has elapsed to produce enough relevant data such that the additional information will be useful to the Commission, we are providing an update to certain information provided in prior 2021 reports in order to assist the Commission.

This concludes IAWC's January 2022 COVID effort report.
