## ROSEWATER WIND FARM LLC'S CONSOLIDATED INITIAL REPORT AND 2<sup>ND</sup> QUARTER 2019 REPORT

This Consolidated Initial Report and 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2019 Report (this "Report") is filed as required by the Commission's Order in this Cause issued on June 5, 2019, in Cause No. 45197. The Order requires Rosewater Wind Farm LLC ("Rosewater") to file an initial report within 30 days of the Order and to file quarterly reports within 30 days of the end of each quarter during the period prior to achieving commercial operation. Because the initial report is due on July 5, 2019, which is after the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2019, Rosewater files this Report that consolidates the initial report and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2019 report for purposes of administrative efficiency. The information in the initial report mirrors the information in the report for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2019. Filing one consolidated report serves administrative efficiency by requiring the Commission to review only one report instead of two duplicate reports. Further, counsel for Rosewater has informed counsel for the OUCC and for the NIPSCO Industrial Group of its intent to file a consolidated initial report and report for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2019 and counsel for the OUCC and counsel for the NIPSCO Industrial Group expressed no objection to Rosewater filing a consolidated report.



This Report provides the required information to the extent such information is known and available. The requested information is as follows:

## (1) Project ownership and name(s) of the Facility.

The owner of the project is Rosewater Wind Farm LLC. The name of the facility is Rosewater Wind Farm.

## (2) Name, title, address, and phone number(s) for primary contact person(s) for the Facility.

#### (3) Number and location of wind turbines deployed.

Rosewater has not yet installed any wind turbines at the project site. The Rosewater Wind Farm will have up to 27 wind turbines.

### (4) Anticipated total output of the Facility.

The anticipated output of the Rosewater Wind Farm is 102 MW.

#### (5) Manufacturer, model number and operational characteristics of turbines.

The Rosewater Wind Farm currently plans to use a mix of Vestas V136-3.6 MW turbines and V150-4.2 MW turbines.

#### (6) Connecting utility(s).

The connecting utility will be NIPSCO.

#### (7) Copy of any Interconnection System Impact Studies prepared by MISO.

The Feasibility Study performed by MISO was attached to the testimony of Ryan J. Brown as Petitioner's <u>Attachment RJB-4</u>. MISO performed a System Impact Study, which was attached to the testimony of Ryan J. Brown as Petitioner's <u>Attachment RJB-5</u>.

#### (8) Expected in-service (commercial operation) date.

The expected commercial operation date is no later than December 31, 2020.

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# (9) An estimate of the engineering/construction timeline and critical milestones for the Facility.

An estimate of the engineering/construction timeline and critical milestones for the Facility are set forth below:

Start of construction: October 1, 2019

Collection system completion: September 30, 2020

Project transmission line and substation completion: September 30, 2020

Turbine mechanical completion: October 31, 2020

Project commercial operation: no later than December 31, 2020

#### (10) The status of the LGIA with MISO.

Rosewater entered into Large Generator Interconnection Agreement ("LGIA") with MISO on August 15, 2018. The fully-executed LGIA was attached to the testimony of Ryan J. Brown as Petitioner's Attachment RJB-6.

(11) The information listed under the Subsequent Reports section, to the extent such information is available.

Finding 6(b) of the Order requires the following information be reported in subsequent reports to the Commission. Responses are provided to the extent known and available.
