You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) has caused the following entry to be made:

On September 27, 2016, the City of Frankfort, Indiana (“Petitioner”) filed *Petitioner’s Motion for Protection of Confidential and Proprietary Information* (“Motion”) in this Cause. In its Motion, Petitioner indicates that certain information (“Confidential Information”) it intends to submit in this matter contains trade secrets as that term is defined under Ind. Code § 24-2-3-2. Information containing trade secrets is excepted from public disclosure under Ind. Code § 5-14-3-4. In support of its Motion, Petitioner also represents that the class cost of service study and related models (including formulas) to be submitted to the Commission as Confidential Information are confidential and protected from disclosure to the public in accordance with 170 IAC 1-5-15.


170 IAC 1-1.1-4 governs the submission of confidential or privileged information to the Commission, and requires the applicant to apply for a finding by the Commission that the information is confidential; however, Confidential Information submitted under 170 IAC 1-1-15 is confidential and protected from disclosure per said Rule.

The Presiding Officers, having considered the Motion, find that given Petitioner’s representations concerning the nature of the Confidential Information, there is sufficient basis for a determination that the Confidential Information should be held as confidential by the Commission on a preliminary basis. Accordingly, Petitioner shall hand deliver the Confidential Information to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge. Petitioner shall also file a Notice of Filing under this Cause specifically referencing this Docket Entry and indicating the Confidential Information has been filed with the Commission. The Confidential Information should be on light green paper, in a sealed envelope clearly marked confidential with the Cause No. noted thereon, and will be treated as confidential on a preliminary basis and excepted from public disclosure in accordance with Ind. Code § 8-1-2-29, Ind. Code § 5-14-3-4, and 170 IAC 1-5-15.

Petitioner may also elect to submit the Confidential Information to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge using the Commission’s Electronic Filing System in lieu of

submitting paper documents. Documents submitted using the "Confidential" tab of the Electronic Filing System are delivered directly to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge, and will be treated as confidential on a preliminary basis and excepted from public disclosure in accordance with Ind. Code §§ 8-1-2-29 and 5-14-3-4. The Notice of Filing should not be submitted using the "Confidential" tab of the Electronic Filing System.
