

Trevor, good to speak with you on the phone today. I'm writing this email to recap our conversation. My understanding of the issue is that there is a question as to whether the property at 4523 Earlham Dr is connected to a septic system or the sanitary sewer system. There was a sewer extension in this neighborhood under the Septic Tank Elimination program in 2015 or 2016. During that project it was brought to our attention by the neighborhood that most of the homes on the north and south side of Earlhamr Dr and the north and south side of Rutgers Rd were connected to a private sewer line that ran behind the homes to a public sewer on Keystone Ave (CEG Fact Sheet attached). We were also told that all the homes that were connected to the private sewer line still had their septic tanks in use. A typical septic system consists of a septic tank for separation of solids, fats, oils, and grease and a soil absorption field. The effluent that leaves the septic tank goes to a soil absorption field (or finger system for a convention septic system) where the soil's natural biological, chemical and physical properties treats the effluent. Normally, when a home is connected to a sanitary sewer system, the septic tank is abandoned by having the contents pumped and the tank filled in with dirt, sand, or gravel. In fact current code requires the tank to be abandoned (410 IAC 6-8.3-90). For some reason these homes, according to the neighborhood, kept their septic tanks but the effluent was discharging to the private sewer line that then ran to a public sewer line. This would mean the homes would still need to periodically pump their septic tanks, just like they would if the tank were still connected to a soil absorption field. This set up makes verification very challenging. A septic tank is designed to hold the water for 24 hours or longer so a typical dye test would be inconclusive unless someone monitored the nearest manhole for a day or two. The inlet and outlet

baffles on the septic tank are not connected directly so a camera run to the tank from the home would not be able to run through the outlet baffle. The only way I can see feasibly verifying where the line from the septic tank at this property goes would be to excavate the line. I've checked our records and can't find any diagrams of the original septic system, but based on the aerial view of the property I can say the above ground pool on this property would almost certainly be where the finger system was (or is). I cannot say definitively, based on our records or knowledge of this property, where the effluent from the tank goes. However, if it is determined that the soil absorption field is still in use, the placement of the above ground swimming pool would almost certainly be in violation of the separation distances set forth in 410 IAC 6-8.3-57(a) and (c). I hope this helps. Let me know if there is anything else we can do to assist.

Earlham Drive/Thompson Road STEP Project

Citizens Energy Group is working to replace failing septic systems with sanitary sewers in the Earlham Drive/Thompson Road area on the city's southeast side as part of the Septic Tank Elimination Program (STEP).

The Problem

Septic systems have a limited life and eventually fail. In addition, the soil types in Marion County are poor for septic waste absorption. As a result, human waste leaches into groundwater, backyards and neighborhood ditches and streams. Failing septic systems are linked to unsafe levels of E. coli in many neighborhood streams and ditches.

The Solution

Approximately 100 properties are part of the Earlham Drive/Thompson Road project, as shown on the map on the reverse side. This project will include the installation of new sanitary sewers.

To address health hazards in our neighborhoods, the Septic Tank Elimination Program (STEP) was implemented to convert many neighborhoods on septic systems to the sanitary sewer system. STEP will bring sewers to hundreds of homes annually to address a majority of the approximately 25,000 Indianapolis homes still on septic systems. Projects are prioritized based on several criteria, three of which are septic system failure rates, housing densities and proximity to a floodplain.

How You Can Help



Earlham Drive/Thompson Road STEP Project

Citizens Energy Group is working to replace failing septic systems with sanitary sewers in the Earlham Drive/Thompson Road area on the city's southeast side as part of the Septic Tank Elimination Program (STEP).

The Problem

Septic systems have a limited life and eventually fail. In addition, the soil types in Marion County are poor for septic waste absorption. As a result, human waste leaches into groundwater, backyards and neighborhood ditches and streams. Failing septic systems are linked to unsafe levels of E. coli in many neighborhood streams and ditches.

The Solution

Approximately 100 properties are part of the Earlham Drive/Thompson Road project, as shown on the map on the reverse side. This project will include the installation of new sanitary sewers.

To address health hazards in our neighborhoods, the Septic Tank Elimination Program (STEP) was implemented to convert many neighborhoods on septic systems to the sanitary sewer system. STEP will bring sewers to hundreds of homes annually to address a majority of the approximately 25,000 Indianapolis homes still on septic systems. Projects are prioritized based on several criteria, three of which are septic system failure rates, housing densities and proximity to a floodplain.



Trevor, good to speak with you on the phone today. I'm writing this email to recap our conversation. My understanding of the issue is that there is a question as to whether the property at 4523 Earlham Dr is connected to a septic system or the sanitary sewer system. There was a sewer extension in this neighborhood under the Septic Tank Elimination program in 2015 or 2016. During that project it was brought to our attention by the neighborhood that most of the homes on the north and south side of Earlhamr Dr and the north and south side of Rutgers Rd were connected to a private sewer line that ran behind the homes to a public sewer on Keystone Ave (CEG Fact Sheet attached). We were also told that all the homes that were connected to the private sewer line still had their septic tanks in use. A typical septic system consists of a septic tank for separation of solids, fats, oils, and grease and a soil absorption field. The effluent that leaves the septic tank goes to a soil absorption field (or finger system for a convention septic system) where the soil's natural biological, chemical and physical properties treats the effluent. Normally, when a home is connected to a sanitary sewer system, the septic tank is abandoned by having the contents pumped and the tank filled in with dirt, sand, or gravel. In fact current code requires the tank to be abandoned (410 IAC 6-8.3-90). For some reason these homes, according to the neighborhood, kept their septic tanks but the effluent was discharging to the private sewer line that then ran to a public sewer line. This would mean the homes would still need to periodically pump their septic tanks, just like they would if the tank were still connected to a soil absorption field. This set up makes verification very challenging. A septic tank is designed to hold the water for 24 hours or longer so a typical dye test would be inconclusive unless someone monitored the nearest manhole for a day or two. The inlet and outlet baffles on the septic tank are not connected directly so a camera run to the tank from the home would not be able to run through the outlet baffle. The only way I can see feasibly verifying where the line from the septic tank at this property goes would be to excavate the line. I've checked our records and can't find any diagrams of the original septic system, but based on the aerial view of the property I can say the above ground pool on this property would almost certainly be where the finger system was (or is). I cannot say definitively, based on our records or knowledge of this property, where the effluent from the tank goes. However, if it is determined that the soil absorption field is still in use, the placement of the above ground swimming pool would almost certainly be in violation of the separation distances set forth in 410 IAC 6-8.3-57(a) and (c). I hope this helps. Let me know if there is anything else we can do to assist.

Beth,

CAD received a complaint from Gretchen Ridener disputing the connection to the sewer and charges from CWA Authority, Inc. (CWA) because there is a septic system installed at the property. CWA is unable to test and conclusively prove the sewer connection. However, based on historical records it is believed that the customer's property is connected to a pre-existing private sewer system that is connected to CWA's sewer. It appears the private line has been abandoned and no one owns the line. It is estimated that over 100+ CWA customers' facilities are set up this way and the facilities are unstable. In addition to the unstable connection, there is a question of whether this customer and others are being billed the correct rate. Due to the complexity of the issues, the case is being referred to the Commission without a determination pursuant to IAC 16-1-5(e).
